### **MAY**

1. Read to your child **EVERY** Day.
2. Continue your grocery store adventures. (October)
3. Continue "Writing" see November.
4. Continue "Labeling items around the house". (December)
5. Continue working on Name recognition. (January)
6. Continue to "Read" signs around town. (February)
7. Working with Letters (March)
8. Vocabulary building. (April)
9. **Sorting/ Categorizing**
  - a. Sort by color, size, shape, etc. Sort your child's clothes, coins, socks, etc. Sort utensils when filling the dishwasher ( all forks here, and all spoons go here, etc)
  - b. Play memory games. Put four or five items on the table. Have your child close his eyes. Remove one of the items. See if your child can remember which item has been removed. When they get good at this game you may have to add more objects to the table and remove two or three at a time. See if your child can name the two or three items that have been removed.
